*Song of Solomon 1:4b*

The Shulamite gives testimony to justify the sentiment of The Daughters of Jerusalem toward The Beloved. The Daughters of Jerusalem are moved by the description of The Beloved by The Shulamite. They celebrate his presence and entrancing ways that are drawn from his passion and romantic notions. They are truly smitten by The Beloved and have good reason to be so.

The Shulamite draws comparison between the two of them, she (To Her Beloved). She confesses her weaknesses and apparent inadequacies. The Shulamite explains why her inadequacies are evident and she humbly desires his understanding. He is the king and she is her subject.

How is your relationship with your spouse? Do you share your life with them in humility and understanding? Are you romantically involved? Do you celebrate each other's presence? Are you enamored by your spouse and wooed by their ways?

What about your relationship and fellowship with God through Jesus Christ? Are you submissive to the ways of the King? Do you find yourself humbled in His presence? Have you confessed your weaknesses and apparent inadequacies to Him? Do you recognize Him as Savior and Lord? Does your praise toward God reflect the text, “Rightly do they love You?”
