**Transforming Daily**  
**“...Who is this ...”**  
*Matthew 21:10*

Can you imagine what it must have been like to see and hear the triumphal entry of Christ into the city of Jerusalem? Everyone was probably shouting, singing, dancing and laughing in celebration. The description of the event in the text is one of elated praise and worship. A ruckus had to be developing because the rest of the city wanted to know what was going on. Fulfillment of the prophecy is what was going on.

Jesus knew exactly what was going on. He knew that in just a few hours most of those very same people who were singing and shouting for Him would be shouting and swearing against Him. Yet He also knew the ones among them that were sincere in their relationship with Him. He also knew who the ones were that wanted to know who He was.

Those three levels of interest still exist today. There are those who know who Christ is and have a personal relationship with Him. Then there are those who don't know who He is and could care less, as a matter of fact, in some cases they work hard to see that others might not come to know who He is either. Then there is a third group of people who don't know who He is, but would like to know who He is if only someone would share with them.

Which group are you in? Do your actions match your praise? Is your praise predicated upon who He is or what He might materially bless you with? Are you sharing your faith that those of the third group might hear and possibly come to know the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ in answer to their inquiry, “Who is this?”
